Breakfast & Lunch



- Breakfast is FREE for ALL students (must apply).
- Breakfast is served daily at 7:45 a.m.
 Please arrive on time for breakfast.

Health Office

- We have a health technician on site most days and a registered nurse here 1 day a week and on call at all times.
- If a students is unable to complete a school day without medication (prescription or non-prescription) please contact the nurse. There is a special form that you we need from your doctor.
- If a student becomes ill during school, parents will be notified. If the parent can't be contacted a person on your emergency sheet will be notified.
- Inform the school nurse if your child has allergies, chronic illnesses, or serious physical problems.
- By state law, schools may not enroll any student without current immunizations. Children not properly immunized will not be admitted to school.
- Please keep your child at home when there are signs of illness such as fever, upset stomach, sore throat or any communicable disease NOTIFY THE OFFICE PLEASE.

Safety Protocols

Emergency Contacts


- Emergency contact names and phone numbers must be current at all times.



Birthday Policy

Communicate with the teacher-prior notice must be made
